ACC News

Happy (almost) Spring Y'all! I don't know about you, but I am really looking forward to the sights, sounds and scents of warmer weather. The greening of our lawns, the bulbs and blossoms starting to sprinkle color in our yards, songbirds singing and mowers roaring. The smell of that fresh cut grass. I really love Spring!

The next ACC Inspection has been tentatively scheduled for the week of April **20th**. While everything will be looked at, the committee will be strongly focused on landscaping and yard issues this season. Please take note that it has been observed that the past two harsh winters have caused numerous homes to have shrubs that are either dead or are in very bad health and will not survive. These issues have been ongoing for long enough that it is apparent that these shrubs should be removed and replaced this season. Please remember that any tree or shrub removal and replacements must be approved by the ACC prior to work beginning. All projects you may have planned for your front yard, or house additions, decks, porches, and fences, even if in the backyard, must be pre-approved by the ACC in order to avoid being fined.

The ACC is actively seeking volunteers. We are down to three members and two more people would more reasonably spread the workload. The work is really not as daunting as it sounds. We make two full neighborhood inspections per year, each of

which takes about five hours. We divide up the homes with violations, and then each member is responsible for communicating with his/her assigned homeowners regarding violations, solutions, fines, etc. We update the Design Guidelines annually, meet as needed (3-4 times per year), respond to homeowner Approval Requests, respond to general questions, etc. This is a very important committee that has been instrumental in helping to improve our neighborhoods appearance and raise our property values over the past few years. Without additional help, the possibility exists that the work of this committee could potentially have to be outsourced in the future, which would most definitely necessitate an increase in dues for all of us. We are trying hard to avoid doing that, so please seriously consider volunteering your services!

Community Concerns

Please remember the parking rules for the neighborhood. Overnight street parking is not allowed per city ordinance. Emergency vehicles must have the right of way. We limit visitor parking to 7 nights. Please be considerate of your neighbors.



Remember: The Speed Limit in our neighborhood is 25 MPH.



Please remember to observe the strict leash laws and keep your pets confined in their yards or on a leash. Also, be courteous and **pick up after your pet**, especially in the area between the two neighborhoods. Pets are not allowed in areas around the pool or tennis courts.



Remember to put trash, garbage and debris out the night before or morning of pickup (not several days). Yard cuttings and debris should be kept out of sight and taken to the curb the evening before or morning of pickup. On holidays, go to the Marietta City Government Sanitation website to check out the pickup dates. The schedule changes on holidays.
