NOTES FROM THE BOARD:

2018 Accomplishments

2018 was another year of significant investment into our community assets.

As with any community approaching 20 years in age, we will

continue to see larger expenses for repair and replacement. Our goal is to minimize the potential impact of the expenses into our overall budget.

Clubhouse

- Both HVAC units have been totally replaced with newer more efficient units.
- Icemaker repairs were made to resolve damage from a leak.
- Cabinetry was repaired to replace rotted and stained wood
- Kitchen faucet was repaired to increase water pressure and stop leaks.

Tennis Gazebo

- Entire Gazebo was repainted and stained.
- Miscellaneous deck boards were replaced.

Playground Upgrades

- A general clean-up of debris and maintenance was performed.
- New mulch was installed.

Pool and Tennis

- Replacement Salt-Cell was installed.
- Replaced all pool umbrellas.
- Underwater lighting repaired.
- Tennis benches were rebuilt with new hardware.

Electrical and Lighting

- Motion activated lighting TBD installed on and near clubhouse.
- Many Landscape Lighting bulbs and fixtures have been replaced at subdivision entrances.

Work Day, April 14, 2018

- Clean the White Entrance Fences
- Plant azaleas on the back side of the Glen monument
- Cleanup remaining limbs and debris along the chain link fence
- Installing Brown Steel Edging along the pool deck by the Parking lot
- Clean the grout in the shower
- Patch and Paint the hole in the pool bathroom wall
- Take down old Christmas lights wrapped around the entrance birch trees
- Install new lights and receptacles at Tennis Pavilion (still TBD)

Community Manager

- We have scaled back the activities our management company has performed on our behalf to deliver better results and to save money.
- These savings are to be reinvested into infrastructure and other improvements.

Frequently Asked Questions (FAQ)

1. How do I make reservations for the clubhouse?

2. When will the pool be closed?

The pool will close on Sunday, October 1, 2018; September 30 is the last day to use the pool.

3. How do I get the code to the tennis courts and/or pool?

Pay your 2018 Dues and the code will be sent to you via email from CMA.

4. How do I get permission to install a fence, playset, change landscaping?

The Architectural Control Committee (ACC) approves all exterior modification to homes. This includes everything from home additions and painting to major landscaping and playsets. The ACC is committed to a quick approval so that you can start your project right away. Those who do not get approval from the committee before beginning their project are subject to a \$100 fine. Members of the committee are listed on the first page and are ready to serve. See design standards pages 7-8. Please download and send the appropriate ACC forms to Cameron Creek/Cameron Park Community Management Associates (CMA) for consideration and processing.

5. Who do I call to report a street light that is out?

There are two power companies in the community. To report a street light problem, call the power company to whom you pay your electric bill, either Cobb EMC at 770.429.3432 or Marietta Power at 770.794.5160.

6. What do I do about a dog running loose in the neighborhood or a dog that is constantly barking?

Call the City of Marietta Code Enforcement at 770.794.5439.

Corollary, how do I stop people walking dogs leaving dog waste on my yard? Please do not leave your Dog's waste in the Large Trash receptacles at the Pool (these might not be emptied every week and smell bad after a week). Please pick up and take your Dog's waste home to your garbage cans.

7. What are the parking rules for the neighborhood?

As a subdivision, we limit visitor street parking to 7 nights. Please be considerate toward your neighbors as to where you park your car on the street (please don't block mailboxes, driveways or sidewalks). The clubhouse parking lot is **NOT** a place to park your excess vehicles.

8. How do I accommodate my extended overnight visitor's vehicles?

Contact any HOA board member for permission to use the clubhouse parking area.

9. What are the garbage and recycling days?

Garbage – Tuesday and Friday

Newspapers – Friday with Garbage pickup (must be in plastic bags or tied up)

Recycling - Friday

Brush and yard trimmings – Wednesday

Annual Meeting Agenda:

- 1. New officers announced and voted upon. Each officer gives a brief Vita.
- 2. Treasurer (or his stand in) Presents 2019 Budget, discuss and vote on Budget
- 3. Reserves Discussion: The current Plan is to increase the annual dues consecutively over the next several years. The Reserve Study shows these increases are required in order to meet the expenses and build up reserves. *The justification for this increase will be explained at the November meeting. Please attend this important meeting.*
- 4. Q&A Session

Common Covenant, Design and Decency Standards Violations

- Failure to request prior approval for any changes to home or site such as fence, play equipment, permanent structure, house color, major landscaping modifications.
- Failure to properly maintain landscaping to HOA standards. Lawns must be maintained regularly including side and rear yards. Trees, bushes, flowers should be kept off the sidewalks.
- Failure to call the Utilities Protection Center at 770-623-4344 to locate and identify all underground cables before any digging is started on your property.
- Failure to pick up and bag dog waste. Please follow the animal control laws and scoop your dog's waste into a bag, seal the bag and dispose of it in your trash (not the trashcan of convenience (like the Clubhouse trashcans).
- Placement of advertising or "for sale" signs on common areas.
- Garbage and recycling cans put out earlier than the evening before pickup and left out days after pickup.
- Speeding on the streets in the subdivision. The speed limit is 25 mph on all streets.
- Illegal overnight street park in violation of our Covenants and Bylaws.
